The past perfect,

*It is a verb tense used to talk about actions that were completed before some point in the past. ... The past perfect tense is **for talking about something that happened before something else.***

Examples:

- Had met: She had met him before the party.
 - Had left: The plane had left by the time I got to the airport.
 - Had written: I had written the email before he apologized.
 - Had wanted: Kate had wanted to see the movie, but she did not have money for the ticket.
